Rocky Mountain Mineral Law Foundation

➤ **Purpose.** The Rocky Mountain Mineral Law Foundation (RMMLF) Scholarship Program was established in 1993 to encourage the study of natural resources law by well qualified law students who have the potential to make significant contributions to scholarship in natural resources law.

➤ **Eligibility.** A law student enrolled full-time at one of the Foundation's Governing Law Schools listed below and who can demonstrate a commitment to study natural resources law or who is undertaking the study of natural resources law is eligible to apply for this scholarship.

➤ **Amount of Scholarships.** Spring 2011 tuition scholarships may cover partial or full tuition costs only. Recent awards ranged from \$1,500-\$11,000. The tuition scholarships must be used at, and will be paid directly to, one of the Governing Law Schools listed below.

➤ **Application Process.** Download the Application form at www.rmmlf.org/geninfo/scholarapp.pdf to review specific requirements, procedures, and deadlines.

➤ **Criteria for Selection.** Applications will be evaluated by the RMMLF Scholarships Committee according to an established set of criteria. The principal selection criteria used by the Committee include:

- potential to make a significant contribution to the field of natural resources law
- academic ability
- leadership ability
- year in law school
- financial need
